LOCOMOTION ON UNIT:

15. Mr. Dickson needs assistance into his w/c, but once there he is able to transport himself where ever he needs to go.

16. Mrs. Jenkins is able to propel self in w/c but frequently requests that staff push her.

17. Mr. Thomas is in a geri-chair while out of bed.

LOCOMOTION OFF UNIT:

18. Mrs. Green is able to ambulate in room and commons area, but requests staff assist and w/c to go long distances.

19. Mr. Blow has remained in room due to flu symptoms.

20. Mrs. Sharp ambulates independetly and goes outside to tend to her flowers.

DRESSING:

21. Mrs. Stucky asks for the staff to lay her clothing out each morning and her nightgown each night, but is able to change by herself.

22. Due to ppor balance and arthritic condition, it takes two staff to help Mr. Kramer get dressed in am and eve. He is unable to assist at all.

23. Mrs. Smith is able to dress herself except for the donning and removal of her TED hose and shoes.

24. Due to her rheumatoid arthritis, Mr. Harper asks staff to help button his shirts.

EATING:

25. Mrs. Sizer is unresponsive and NPO and receives all of her nourishment through a feeding tube/pump at night.

26. Mr. Schmidt is blind, but is able to feed himself after staff seasons his food and cuts up his meet.

27. Mrs. Cairns has to be feed by staff, she makes no attempt to hold utensils or pick up food or drink.

28. Mr. Netter is able to feed himself, but has history of choking, staff needs to be nearby when he eats.

TOILETING:

29. Mr. Walker is in the last stages of Alzheimer's and it incont. of both bowel and bladder. Is changed every two hours by two staff.

30. Mrs. Jensen is confused at times, is able to toilet self but needs staff assist to remind her to zip up her pants and straighten her clothing.

31. Mr. Decker has a catheter which staff has to empty. He is also incontinent of bowel and unable to clean himself.

32. Mrs. Jacobs is able to ambulate and toilet herself without reminding or assist from staff.

PERSONAL HYGIENE:

33. Due to poor vision, Mr. Smith needs assist with ADLs, staff hands him razor, washcloth, etc. and he is able to perform the tasks himself.

34. Mrs. Parker is depressed and unmotivated, after cuing and encouragement, she is able to perform hygiene herself. to her flowers.

35. Mr. White is unable to perform any of his hygiene by himself.

36. Mrs. Morgan is very independent and refuses to allow anyone to help her and always looks well groomed.

BATHING:

37. Mr. Keens is afraid of water. He is given a full sponge bath twice a week. He is actively involved in the procedure.

38. Mrs. Flint is very shy, with verbal cuing takes twice weekly showers. She is able to bathe herself with periodic oversight.

39. Mr. Jones is dying of cancer and bed ridden. He receives a total sponge bath every night.

40. Mrs. Crocker is very independent, but due to back pain, she requires assist with washing her lower legs and feet.
