Title: Restorative Nursing Coordinator

Primary Function: A member of the inter-disciplinary team who has had special training in Rehabilitation care.

Reports To: Director of Nursing or Nursing Department Designee

Qualifications:

- Graduate of an accredited school of nursing.
- Current license
- Two years experience in long-term care and two years experience in a supervisory position.
- Knowledge of long-term care, OBRA and rehabilitation care.
- Ability to coordinate Nursing Restorative Program and provide guidance and training to other nurses, RNAs, CNAs regarding restorative procedures.
- Ability to facilitate interdisciplinary teamwork.

Supervises: Restorative Nursing Assistants

Responsibilities:

1. Coordinates restorative nursing program throughout the facility.
2. Coordinates completion of initial assessment(s) for new admissions to Identify restorative potential.
3. Works closely with the therapist(s) to establish restorative nursing goals And interventions for the resident's care plan.
4. Assigns duties to and supervises follow through of RNAs/CNAs.
5. Completes monthly summaries on residents in the restorative program.
6. Assists with development of policies, procedures and budget for restorative nursing program.
7. Assists with discharge planning and care conferences as appropriate.
8. Participates in performance reviews of RNAs/CNAs.
9. Inservices nursing staff on restorative nursing program(s).
