- Title:** **Restorative Nursing Assistant**
A member of the interdisciplinary team who has completed an on-the-job Training program.
- Reports To:** Director of Nursing or Nursing Department Designee (e.g. ADON and Restorative Nursing Coordinator)
- Qualifications:**
- Certified Nursing Assistant (CAN) or graduate of a COTA or PTA program.
 - Ability to provide guidance and training of other CNAs and residents/patients with simple, non-complex nursing restorative procedures.
 - Ability to function in a team environment.
 - Ability to communicate in writing and record patient / resident responses to treatment preferred.
 - Experience in geriatric restorative care is preferred.
- Supervises:** NONE
- Responsibilities:**
1. Follow through with individual and / or group programs initiated by specialized therapies and / or restorative nursing.
 2. Maintain individual records of restorative nursing activities for each
 3. Record patient / resident daily activities and file as instructed.
 4. Act as a resource for CNAs in nursing restorative techniques.
- Physical Demands**
Constant standing, walking and handling patients / resident during working hours. Good physical and mental health.
- Special Demands:**
Must have a genuine interest in the rehabilitation of the geriatric patient resident. Must have some intuition and judgement in recognizing symptoms indicative of a patient's / resident's adverse reaction to treatment. Work under close supervision.
