

Jumpstart Your Clinical Improvement Process

High-Risk Pressure Ulcers

- 1** QI/QM reports accessed through the CASPER reporting system will show your nursing home's most recently transmitted MDS data for high-risk pressure ulcers. To access instructions for obtaining your MDS QI/QM reports, [click here](#). To obtain your CASPER reports, go to the CMS MDS internet page used for transmitting data. When running your reports, be sure to select the *MDS QI/QM Package*.
- 2** Within your package report, locate the resident level Quality Measures/Indicator report. Under the *Skin Care* column, pressure ulcers/hi; review those residents who triggered the HR PU measure.
- 3** For each resident identified in Step 2, complete a pressure ulcer process review audit. For the audit, [click here](#). Employ [an action plan](#) for any "no" answers identified during the audit.
- 4** Ensure that MDS assessments are being coded correctly. To see which MDS items trigger the measure, [click here](#). Compare the most recent MDS assessment to wound documentation found within the resident record to make sure the two coincide. For support and further training for coding of MDS, [click here](#).
- 5** Discuss wound healing and progress of above identified actions daily at stand-up meetings and 24-hour resident condition reports. Also include updates/discussions at risk and QA meetings. Update action plans as needed to ensure progress is being made.
- 6** Advancing Excellence in America's Nursing Homes is a national effort to improve quality in key areas, including high-risk pressure ulcers. - 7** Recognize that pressure ulcers are sometimes unavoidable, however, review current processes and be able to explain your practices and QM score.
