

# Adult Preventive/Diabetic Standing Orders

Administer services for every visit according to the orders below.

- 1) Monitor and record **B/P** (on the same arm) every visit.
- 2) Measure and record the patient's **weight** every visit.
- 3) For patients 65 or older, administer **annually** the **influenza vaccination 0.5 ml IM**
- 4) Administer the **pneumococcal pneumonia vaccination (PPV) 0.5 ml IM or SubQ** to patients 65 or older, meeting the following criteria.
  - a) Vaccination status is unknown or they have not received the vaccine.
  - b) Vaccine was received when the patient was less than 65 and it was more than 5 years ago.
- 5) Provide a **fecal occult blood testing** packet to patient if over the age of 50 and if not completed within the last year.
  - a) Provide instructions for completing the packet.
  - b) Provide instructions for mailing the cards or returning the cards to the office.
- 6) For women aged 50 or older, determine if they have had an annual **mammogram** in the past year. If not, and the woman agrees to obtain a mammogram:
  - a) Complete the referral for a mammogram for the provider to approve.

## Diabetic Patients

- 1) If a **dilated eye exam** was not done in the past year, complete a referral for an ophthalmology/optometry dilated eye exam for provider to approve.
- 2) If **HgbA1C** was not done in past 6 months, complete a lab requisition.
- 3) If a **lipid profile** was not done in the past year:
  - a) Complete a lab requisition for fasting lipid profile.
