Full group session:

Duration – 50 minutes

Format – Presenter delivers a broad topic to the full conference audience, including public health professionals, healthcare providers, nonprofit organizations, local leaders and advocates, and anyone committed to building healthier communities.

Panel presentation:

Duration – 50 minutes, plus 10 minutes of audience Q&A

Format – Bring your small team and group of experts for a more conversational, facilitated discussion.

Breakout session:

Duration – 50 minutes, plus 10 minutes of audience Q&A

Format – Presenter facilitates networking with a smaller group (less than 50 participants) on a particular topic.

Workshop:

Duration – 90 minutes

Format – Presenter leads an in-depth discussion and collaborative problem-solving on a particular topic.
