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Mount Hope Nursing Center Receives Top 20 Ranking in Statewide Nursing Facility Care

Mt. Hope, KS – Mount Hope Nursing Center has been recognized as one of the top 20 facilities in Kansas for quality nursing care in a report by the Great Plains Quality Innovation Network, published in May of 2016. Mount Hope Nursing Center ranked 13th of 333 nursing facilities across the state, earning a spot within the top four percent of Kansas nursing homes.

“We work hard to offer what our residents need and want, while offering them a safe environment. It’s nice to see our hard work recognized,” said Gina Terry, Administrator at Mount Hope Nursing Center.

The Great Plains Quality Innovation Network report, conducted quarterly, evaluates nursing facilities based on a composite score which reflects success in 13 long-stay measures determined by the National Nursing Home Quality Care Collaborative.

Among those measures are a decrease in falls with major Injury, pain, catheters, urinary tract infections, incontinence, physical restraints, long-stay pressure ulcers, long-stay anti-psychotic medication, depression, weight loss and a number of others, allowing facilities to determine the areas in which they wish to be evaluated. The number of cases of the flu and pneumonia are also taken into consideration.

The Great Plains Quality Innovation Network’s evaluation system suggests that facilities should strive to achieve a composite score of six or under to ensure that residents are receiving proper care. Mount Hope Nursing Center continues to meet this standard, with a current composite score of 5.24 in the second quarter of 2017, coming in 0.76 under the Network’s suggested goal.

“Great Plains Quality Innovation Network’s evaluation system gives us constant data, which enables us to continue setting the bar higher and higher against our peers,” Terry said.
