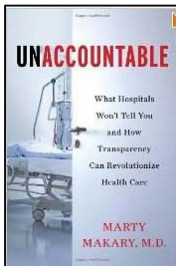




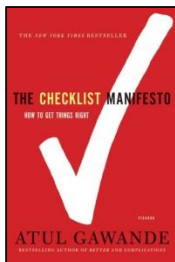
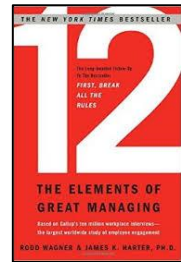
Recommended Patient Safety Reading

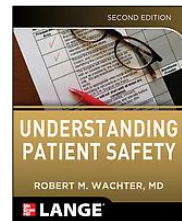

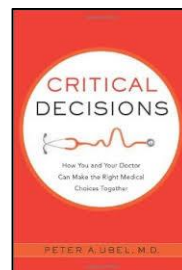
